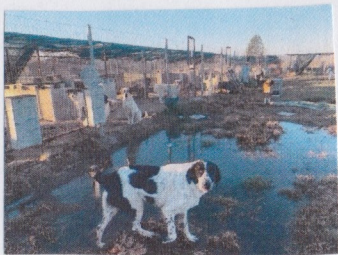

What is the project about?

It is a project placed in Greece which takes care of the homeless dogs as well as dogs that need help in general. The medical care of the almost 1000 dogs in the animal shelter as well as the care of the daily new arrivals is very expensive and tears a huge hole in the animal shelter finances. In addition there are the costs for daily castrations, medical emergencies for example dogs hit by a car or the treatment of Mediterranean diseases. All of these costs can be covered but that requires a lot of money. That is the reason why the project asks for donations so that they can help the dogs.



Goals of the project:

The main Goal is to help as many dogs as possible. They also want to sustainably improve the situation of street dogs. The project also wants to build up an own animal shelter to have a safe place to take care of the dogs, as well as a place where the dogs feel comfortable after everything they have been through.



Why is the project important:

The suffering of dogs in Greece is great and the monthly veterinary costs are currently up to 15.000 euro. These are costs that can not be managed alone in the long term. In order to be able to help as many dogs as possible, the shelter needs financial support.
